

## SPANISH MAJOR WITH EDUCATION CERTIFICATION

### MAJOR SEQUENCE

Only Spanish courses numbered 145 or above may be taken for major credit. If a student's background is not sufficient to begin the major with SPAN 145, all courses taken below 145 will be counted as electives. SPAN 146 or equivalent is a prerequisite for all other Spanish courses. For permission to student teach, a G.P.A. of 3.0 in major courses is required. To obtain certification candidates must pass the required Spanish Praxis exams and receive the Advanced-Low rating in the American Council on the Teaching of Foreign Languages (ACTFL) Oral Proficiency Interview (OPI). In addition the student must meet all Education Department requirements . Certification in Spanish is valid for K-12.
