Upon graduation, a student will receive a Bachelor of Science in Business Administration (B.S.B.A.) with a major in International Business.
*International Business majors are required to fulfill one of the following:
(A) Foreign Language proficiency, as determined by the Foreign Language Department, equal to a 146 (Conversation and Composition) level of proficiency.
(B) The requirement is met for students for whom English is a second Language.
(C) Students who have successfully completed a minimum 9 credit hours in an international internship or study abroad program.

## General Information:

A student must earn a minimum of 120 credit hours to be awarded the baccalaureate degree. The number of credit hours required for graduation may be higher in certain major programs or if the student elects to pursue a second major. International Business requires 124 credits.
Beyond the requirements of the Core Curriculum and of a student's chosen major program, the balances of the credit hours required for graduation are "free electives."
