While determining your eligibility for financial aid for the 2025-26 academic year, we have discovered conflicting information on your Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).

- There was an amount reported in *College Grants, Scholarships, or AmeriCorps Benefits* reported as income to the IRS.
- You would only include grant and scholarship aid **THAT WAS REPORTED TO THE IRS AS INCOME.** This only includes the amount of grant & scholarships that exceeds your tuition & fees at the institution you attended.
- Parents sometimes incorrectly assume that any grant/scholarship reported on a 1098 form should be entered. Only grant/scholarship aid that was issued as income and therefore included as taxable income on the federal tax return, should be reported.
