While determining your eligibility for financial aid for the 2025-26 academic year, we have discovered conflicting information on your Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).

- There was an amount reported in **College Grants, Scholarships, or AmeriCorps Benefits** reported as income to the IRS.
