Learn about the cultural, linguistic, and instructional richness of Australia! This short-term, faculty-led study abroad program will explore Australian culture and systems of schooling through in-country examinations and explorations. An undergraduate study of multicultural, linguistic, and instructional methods and graduate inquiry into ESL instructional theory and practice will be reinforced through collaboration with practicing host teachers in local classrooms. Further, the structured assignments present significant potential for forging lifelong collaborative international learning relationships. Under the leadership of the Education Department faculty, Denise Reboli, Ph.D., and Jill Yurko, Ph.D., students will spend time in Brisbane and Sydney, Australia, cuddling live koalas and exploring renowned landmarks.

The Program

Australia, a continent of riches, highlights cultural diversity as one of the nation's greatest strengths. As a vibrant, multicultural home to the world's oldest continuous cultures, as well as citizens who identify with more than 270 ancestries, Australia presents an ideal setting to explore global connections. This study abroad program is structured to immerse students in Australian schools in Queensland, Australia, and cultural experiences spanning to New South Wales. The schools of the Sunshine Coast offer a rich environment for teaching and learning about diversity, equity, and inclusion. Participants will be encouraged to compare their lived experience within the Australian framework of language and culture. In addition to time in the schools, we'll enjoy Australian cuisine, learn about the wildlife, enjoy the natural landscape and iconic sites—all while challenging our assumptions about what it means to be a citizen of the world in Australia.

Estimated program cost of \$5,200 covers all travel, accommodations, most meals, lectures, site visits, emergency insurance, and 3-credit King's College tuition. Financial aid and scholarships are available.
