PROGRAM DESCRIPTIONS

ADVISING/TECHNOLOGY SESSION | MCGOWAN SCHOOL OF BUSINESS

Students will review the Self-Service – Student Planning section to view their schedule, see room locations, find their advisor and have a brief presentation on how to add/drop courses and use the progress report. The Technology session offers an introduction to technological resources available at King's and seeks to verify that students can access and log-in to those resources. Topics covered will include, password creation, Outlook email, Self-Service, Office 365, Moodle, Campus Shield, and online training resources.

DIVERSITY/INCLUSION | CAMPUS CENTER 3FL

Tackle different components of diversity, equity, and inclusion (DEI) in a fun and engaging way. Participate in our meaningful conversations, competitive fun, and find out how King's values DEI across campus.

CAMPUS SAFETY | BURKE AUD., MCGOWAN SCHOOL OF BUSINESS
