PROGRAM DESCRIPTIONS

ADVISING/TECHNOLOGY SESSION | MCGOWAN SCHOOL OF BUSINESS

Students will review the Self-Service – Student Planning section to view their schedule, see room locations, find their advisor and have a brief presentation on how to add/drop courses and use the progress report. The Technology session offers an introduction to technological resources available at King's and seeks to verify that students can access and log-in to those resources. Topics covered will include, password creation, Outlook email, Self-Service, Office 365, Moodle, Campus Shield, and online training resources.

DIVERSITY/INCLUSION | CAMPUS CENTER 3FL

In this interactive activity, students will face unexpected challenges that encourage them to think critically, adapt, and collaborate with others. Through the experience, participants will explore different perspectives and strengthen the skills needed to connect across differences.

CAMPUS SAFETY | BURKE AUDITORIUM, MCGOWAN SCHOOL OF BUSINESS

Students will learn about safety on our campus and in the surrounding area. The presentation will review our Campus Shield app and security measures to be aware of as you begin your college experience.

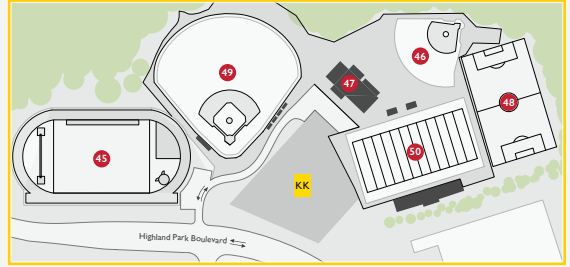

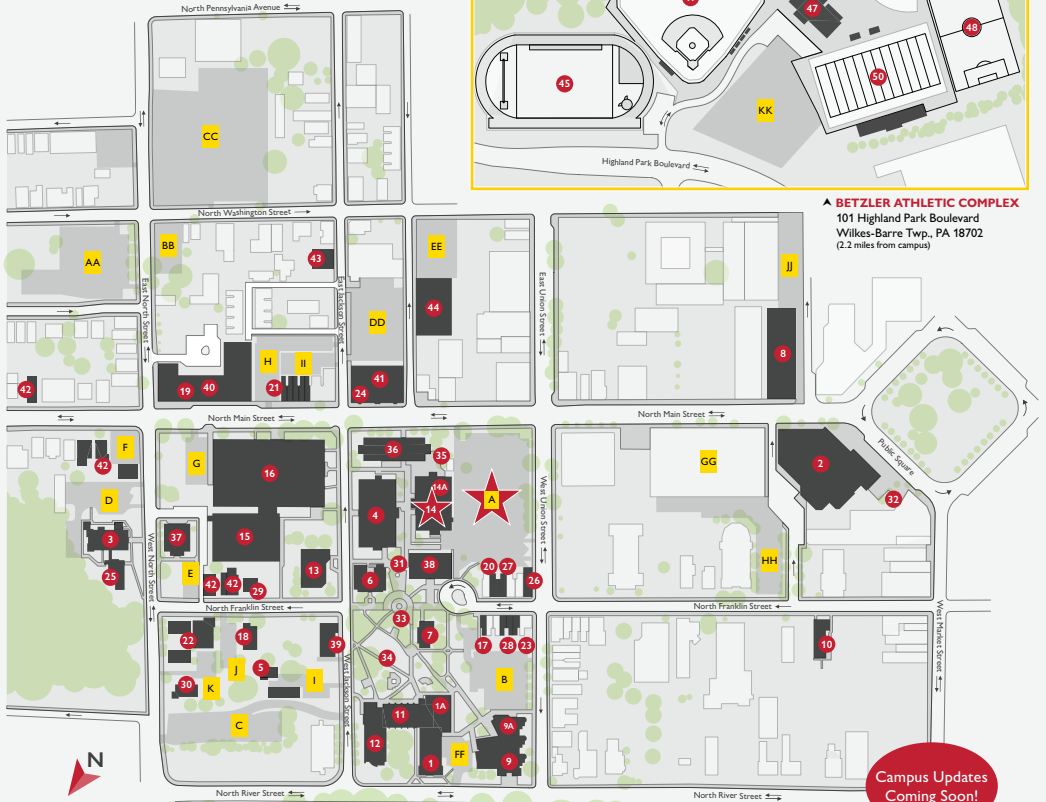
