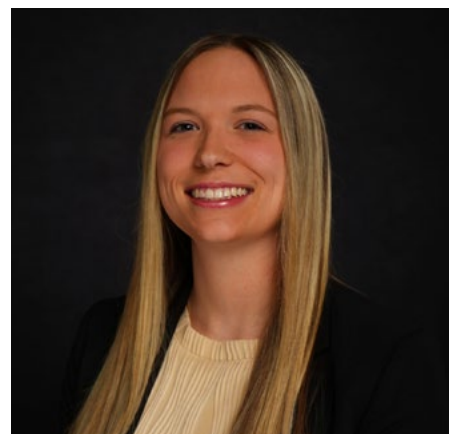
### OPPORTUNITIES AT KING'S COLLEGE
