OPPORTUNITIES AT KING'S COLLEGE

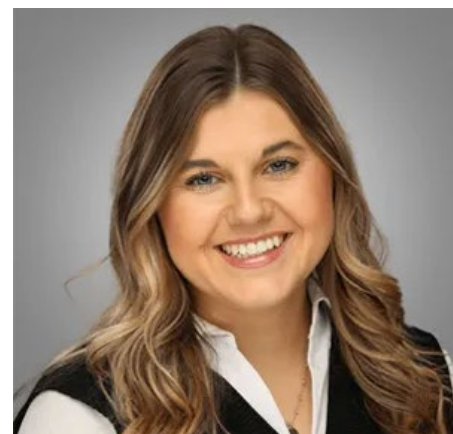
