** In addition to FREN 114, FREN 231, FREN 233, and FREN 480, all students majoring in French are required to take a French Literature Course (FREN 235, FREN 341, FREN 342, or an appropriate FREN 291 or 391) and three (3) additional French Major Courses (for a total of 24 credits) from the following list to satisfy the major requirements. *(Keep in mind that upper-level French Major Courses are offered on a rotating basis.)*

NOTE: If a student begins his/her study of a language at the beginning or intermediate level (FREN 111 - 113), he/she/they should consult with the Department Chair as early as possible to discuss any necessary adjustments to the suggested sequence, such as taking multiple French classes in a single semester, taking French and/or Core classes during the summer session, or studying abroad in a French speaking country.

General Information:

A student must earn a minimum of 120 credit hours to be awarded the baccalaureate degree. The number of credit hours required for graduation may be higher in certain major programs or if the student elects to pursue a second major. Beyond the requirements of the Core Curriculum and of a student's chosen major program, the balances of the credit hours required for graduation are "free electives."
