- If a student begins his/her study of a language at the beginning or intermediate level (SPAN 111 113), he/she/they should consult with the Department Chair as early as possible to discuss any necessary adjustments to the suggested sequence, such as taking multiple Spanish classes in a single semester, taking Spanish and/or Core classes during the summer session, or studying abroad in a Spanish speaking country.
