Upon graduation, a student will receive a Bachelor of Science in Business Administration (B.S.B.A.) with a major in Management and a concentration in Health Care Management.

General Information:

A total of 126 credits is required for the **BSBA.Management-Health Care Management**. The third and fourth years of the program include 12 credits of graduate-level coursework (HCA 500, HCA 576, HCA 571, and HCA 507). For students transitioning into the 3+2 Master of Health Care Administration program, the 12 graduate credits completed during the third and fourth years will also apply toward the master's degree. To be eligible for application toward the master's degree, students must earn a grade of B or better in each graduate-level course. Graduate credits completed with a grade below B will satisfy bachelor's degree requirements, as applicable, but will not count toward the master's degree.
