THE Duquesne 3 + 3 PATHWAY FOR QUALIFIED STUDENTS:

- A 3+3 pathway in which King's students spend three years at King's and then three years at Duquesne, with credits earned at the successful completion of the first year of law school transferring back to King's to satisfy final graduation requirements. Must earn a minimum of 90 credits at King's College.

BENEFITS

- Apply by priority deadline of April 1st. Final deadline is May 1st of your junior year.
- Preferred admission without the competition of the rest of the applicant pool.
- For the 3+3 program, a student will be eligible for traditional financial aid options.

QUALIFICATIONS

- Completed at least three years of coursework for the 3+3 program including 90 credits earned at King's College.
- Earned a minimum cumulative GPA OF 3.5
- GPA is calculated by the Law School Admission Council (LSAC).
- An LSAT score at or above the 60th percentile on the Law School Admission Test. along with a strong recommendation from the King's College pre-law advisor.
- Interviewed successfully with the School of Law prior to receiving a final admission decision.
- Remain in good academic and disciplinary standing. Meet all fitness and character criteria for admission.
