Healthcare in Lima, Peru



Under the leadership of King's College Physician Assistant Faculty, this 2-week interdisciplinary program abroad will provide students with an opportunity to serve patients in the Holy Cross community's Policlínico (multi-specialty clinic) and, also, to experience the Holy Cross's broader mission by living at the Holy Cross Peyton Center in the Canto Grande neighborhood of Lima. Finally, the group will tour to see the cultural and natural richness of the area.

The Program

This medical service immersion program is geared towards students in health science majors and is affiliated with the Holy Cross community of priests, sisters, and lay people in the Canto Grande neighborhood of Lima, Peru. The Holy Cross have sponsored the Policlínico Parroquial Hermano Andres medical clinic, schools, churches, and other services in this area for many years. This 1-credit course will focus on assisting and observing nurses, physical therapists, and doctors at the Policlínico and, also, on patient education especially focusing on chronic health problems such as anemia and diabetes.

King's students and faculty will experience tremendous hospitality while in residence at the Peyton Center. This program has been running successfully since 2019. "I had an amazing time learning so much about how to become a better PA," said one student. "The entire trip was filled with intercultural experiences," said another student.

The cost of the program is estimated to be \$5,000. The price includes all travel, accommodations, excursions, site visits, meals, emergency medical insurance, and one-credit King's College tuition. Financial aid and scholarships are available.
