

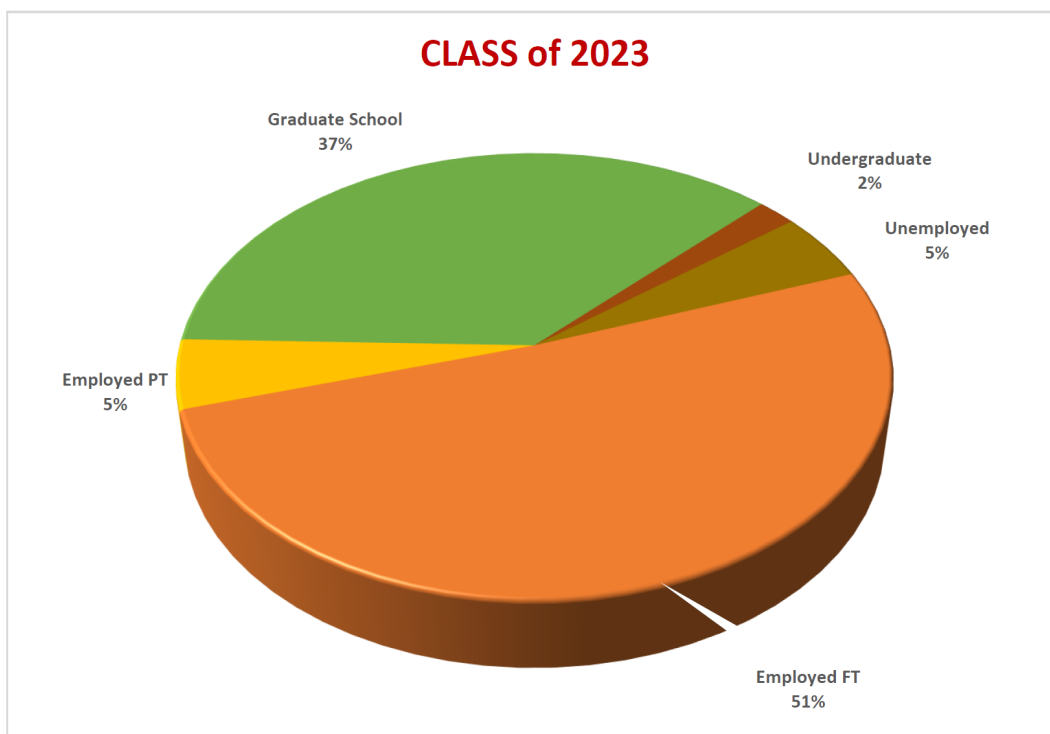
Placement Highlights For The Class of 2023

Each year the King's College Office of Career Planning prepares a report of our annual survey on the placement status of the graduates from the previous academic year. Information from this report has proven helpful to faculty, administrators, and staff in providing data to the stakeholders of King's College. The report includes highlights of the data gathered on the Class of 2023. An on-line survey was administered in person by the staff of the Office of Career Planning during graduation practice, and combined with the knowledge rate, this has yielded a much greater response rate than the previous year. We anticipate that this is a comparative representation of the entire population of graduates.

- **79.6%**, or 319 of the 401 members of the class of 2023 obtaining a Bachelor's Degree responded to the survey or had information gathered from the knowledge rate.

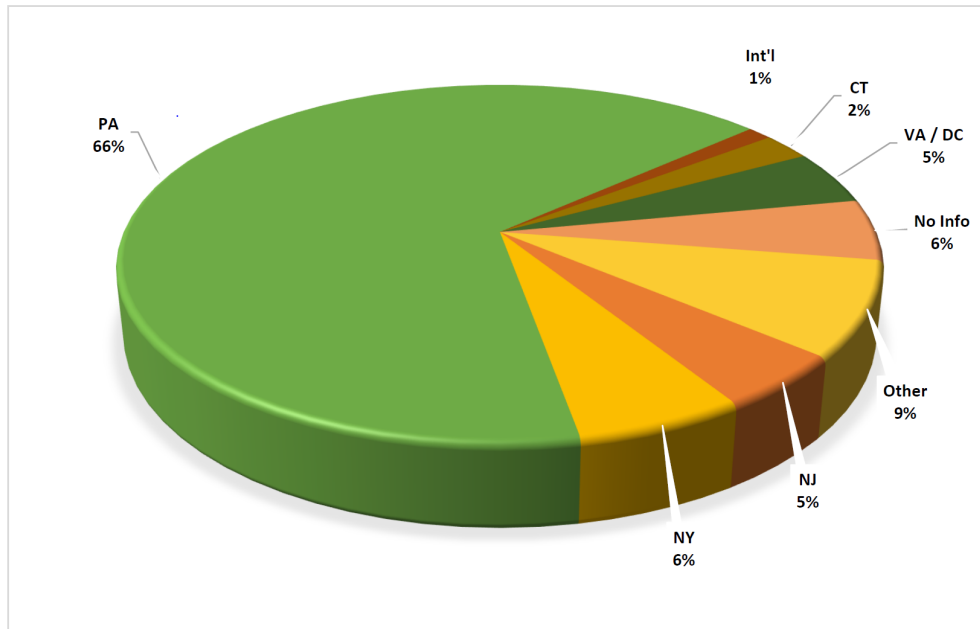
Of the responding graduates:

- **95%** are employed full-time or part-time, or enrolled in undergraduate, graduate or professional school, or doing volunteer work.
- **51%** are employed full-time (includes military service).
- **37%** are attending graduate school or other professional school.
- **5%** are employed in part-time positions.
- **2%** are doing volunteer work.
- **5%** are unemployed and seeking employment.



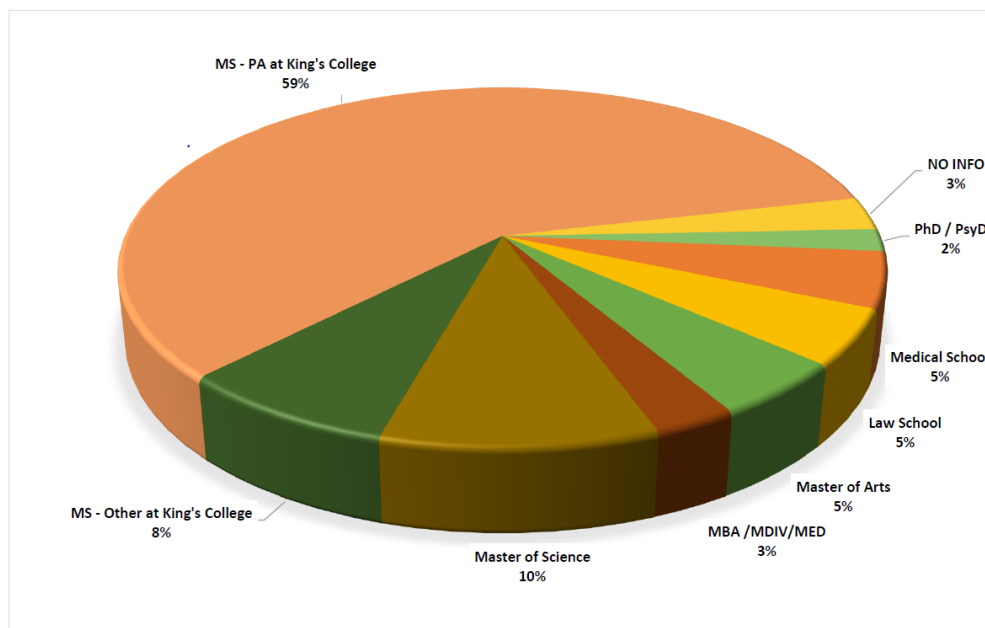
Geographic Employment

Many of graduates have secured employment in the Northeast Region of the country. Pennsylvania, New York, and New Jersey together employ **77%** of the full-time responding graduates.



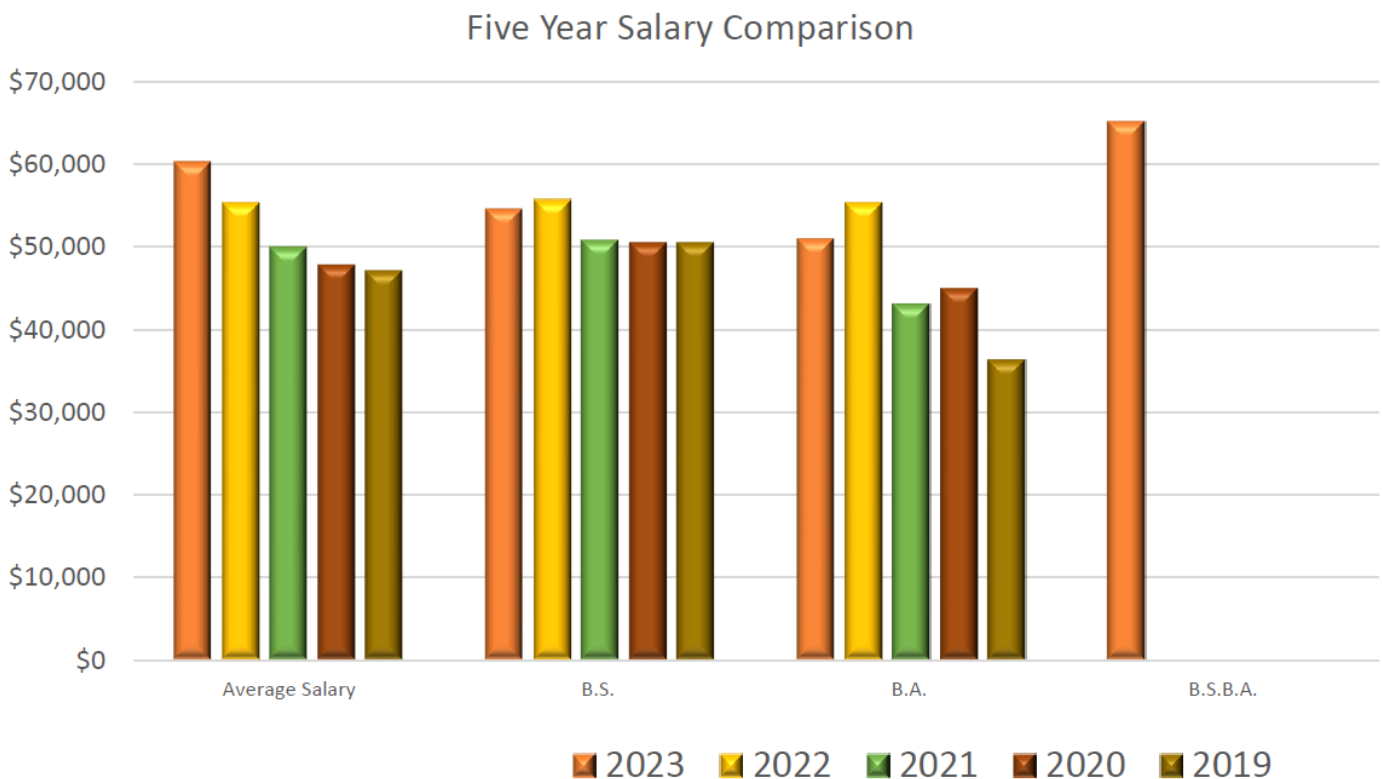
Graduate School Enrollments

Of the responding population, **37%** are attending graduate or professional school, which is a slightly higher than in previous years. Of the students attending graduate school, **59%** are pursuing a Master of Science Degree in Physician Assistant Studies at King's College. Of those seeking a Master of Science degree, **45%** (and **8%** of the overall graduate school population) are continuing their education at King's College.



Salary Information

Salary information for the Class of 2023 was received from about **38%** of the full-time employed graduates who responded to the salary question on the survey. The average salary for 2023 graduates was \$60,258. Bachelor of Science degree graduates were offered average salaries of \$54,592, Bachelor of Arts degree graduates averaged \$50,963, and Bachelor of Science in Business Administration averaged \$65,165. There are significant variations in salary depending on academic major, therefore the B.S.B.A. salaries were reported separately beginning this year. These averages are consistent with the previous years and should reflect average salaries for most graduates employed full-time.
