

Federal TEACH Grant

The Teacher Education Assistance for College and Higher Education (TEACH) Grant program provides grants **up to** \$4,000 per academic year to students.

- TEACH Grant recipients must be Education majors in their **junior or senior** year at King's College, formally admitted into the Education Program, and maintain a cumulative Grade Point Average of 3.25 or higher.
- Graduate students enrolled in the Education program are also eligible to be considered for a TEACH Grant.
- TEACH Grant recipients must complete the <u>Free Application for Federal Student Aid</u>.
- TEACH Grant recipients must be a U.S. citizen or eligible non-citizen.
- TEACH Grant recipients must be enrolled in a bachelor's or master's degree program that is necessary to begin a career in teaching.
- TEACH Grant recipients must agree to teach for four years at a low-income school or educational service agency.
- The King's College TEACH Grant Application must be submitted annually to receive a TEACH grant.
- TEACH Grant applicants must complete the <u>TEACH Grant Counseling session</u> annually to receive a TEACH Grant.
- Once approved, TEACH Grant applicants must sign the <u>TEACH Grant Agreement to Serve</u> annually to receive a TEACH Grant.
- If you are a graduate student, you are enrolled in a master's degree program. Please note: **Certificate only students are not eligible.**

Awards are based on enrollment status and will be subject to the terms of the Budget Control Act of 2011, which reduces awards by 5.70%.

The terms and conditions of this service obligation are explained in the TEACH Agreement to Serve.

IMPORTANT: If you do not complete your service obligation, all TEACH Grant funds you received will be converted to a Direct Unsubsidized Loan. Upon this conversion you must repay this loan with interest charged from the date of disbursement.
