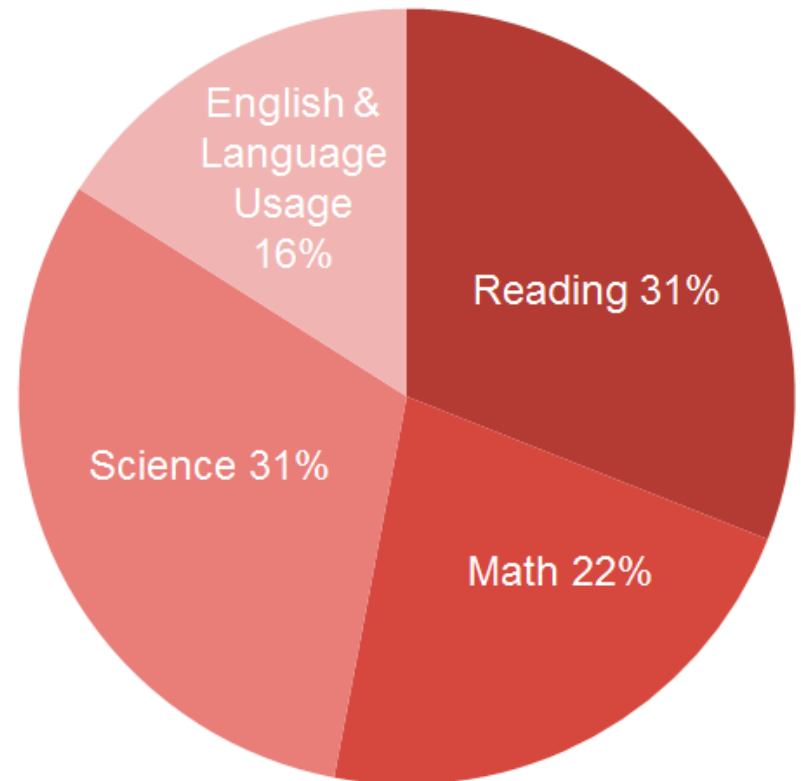
The TEAS will:

- Measure the level of general academic preparedness of students entering a health science program of study.
- Diagnose the strengths and weaknesses of admitted students immediately following entry into a health science program of study.
- TEAS is used by **1,900+** programs across the country and has been found to be a statistically significant predictor of early nursing program success.

ATI TEAS Outline and Weighting

- Four-part multiple choice exam: Math, Science, Reading and English & Language Usage
- Total testing time: 209 minutes
- Total number of questions: 170 with 20 are un-scored pretest questions

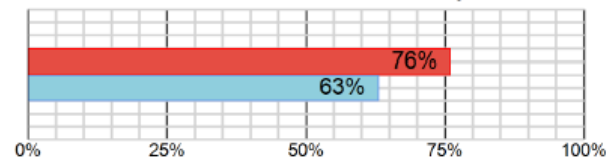

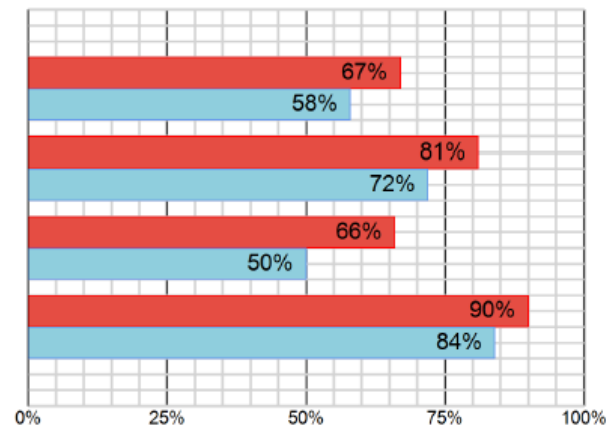

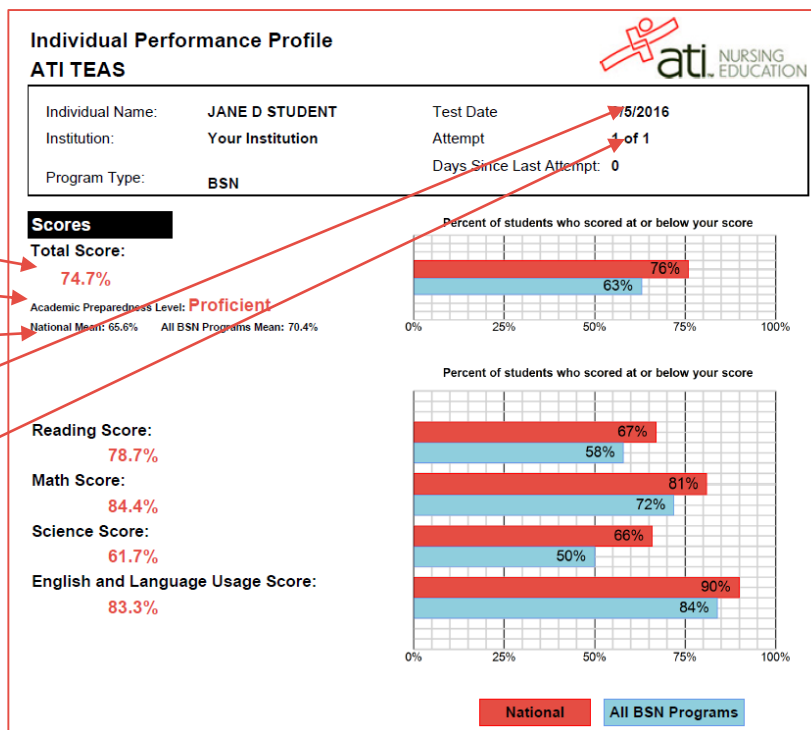

- Proctorio offers a variety of secure exam settings including video, audio, and screen recording designed to maintain the integrity of the assessment and ensure uncompromised exam results.
- Tech requirements:
 - *Microphone: Any microphone, either internal or external*
 - *Webcam: 320x240 VGA resolution (minimum) internal or external*
 - *Proctorio Google Chrome extension will need to be installed on device*

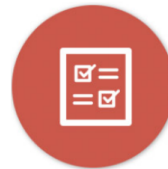
