

Assistant Professor of Healthcare Administration (tenure-track)

This appointment is for one 9-month tenure-track position at the Assistant Professor level to start August 2020, with the possibility of summer teaching.

The successful candidate will have the ability to teach both residential and online graduate-level courses in two or more of the following areas: Public and/or Population Health, Health Promotion, Health Policy, US Health Systems, and Epidemiology. In addition to teaching at the graduate level, responsibilities may also include teaching courses in undergraduate health services management.

Candidates must have a terminal degree from an institution regionally accredited by an agency recognized by the U.S. Department of Education (or international equivalent) in Public Health or Healthcare Administration, or related field (Candidates must be able to demonstrate substantial work in health education/promotion); strong evidence of excellent in teaching; a record of successful research and publication or strong evidence of potential; a demonstrated record of professional experience in the field; and a demonstrated record of membership in relevant professional organizations.

The successful candidate will advise graduate students; mentor master's student capstones; engage in scholarly research, including publishing; engage in multidisciplinary collaborations; and participate in service activities within the department, college, university, and profession and support the Holy Cross Mission and Catholic identity of the College.
