We are looking for a degreed civil engineer, with a strong background in transportation engineering and possessing industry experience. CE 420 Transportation Engineering (3 credits): This course focuses on the civil engineering operation, design, and construction of transportation systems. Particular areas of interest include transportation planning and the four-step process; road vehicle performance; horizontal and vertical alignment; geometric highway design; traffic operation, flow, and control; traffic safety; and the design and management of pavement systems. Prerequisites include Dynamics, Civil Engineering Materials, and Hydraulics and Hydrology.
