

## Director of RN to BS in Nursing

King's College, Wilkes-Barre, PA, seeks a 12-month tenure track faculty to serve as program director for the RN to BS in Nursing program. The position requires flexible teaching hours. Responsibilities include teaching across the RN to BS in Nursing program as well as the 1-2-1 Dual Degrees in Nursing curriculum, involvement in student recruitment and advisement, scholarly activity and serving on departmental and college committees.

The R.N. to Bachelor of Science in Nursing program supports an agreement that King's has reached with Luzerne County Community College. This partnership is designed for students to enroll in courses at King's in the first year, complete the Associate degree in nursing at LCCC in the second and third years, and complete coursework for the Bachelor of Science in Nursing at King's during the fourth year. This program provides students with a seamless pathway to a traditional, four-year experience in the environment of a small college with a strong liberal arts foundation that leads to a Bachelor of Science in Nursing degree.

The director working with the chairperson will coordinate scheduling, review, and revise the curriculum, and establish and maintain accreditation at the national and state levels. The director working with the chairperson will assist with the curricular development of additional nursing programs. The director will teach nine credits per semester while performing duties associated with the administration of the program.

Successful candidates will minimally possess an earned Doctorate in nursing, a minimum of 3 years of clinical experience, and a minimum of 3 years of experience in baccalaureate nursing education. Consideration will be given to applicants who are completing their PhD dissertation or scholarly project component of their DNP education. Successful candidates will also have experience with accreditation of nursing programs, potential for teaching excellence, administrative ability, including interpersonal, leadership and management skills, and the capacity to work positively with internal college communities (both King's College and Luzerne County Community College) as well as with external medical and health systems. Successful candidate will support the Holy Cross Mission and Catholic identity of the College.
