PROGRAM DESCRIPTIONS

**WELLNESS | MAFFEI THEATRE, ADMINISTRATION BUILDING**

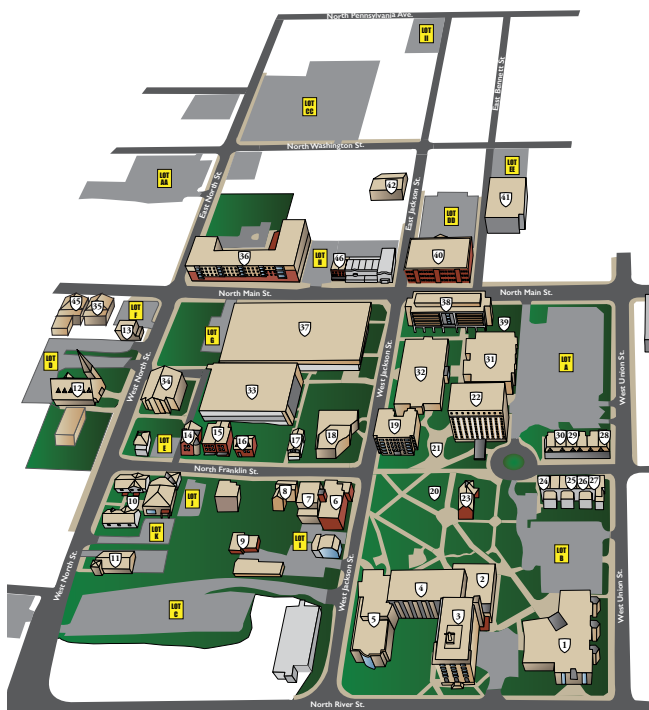

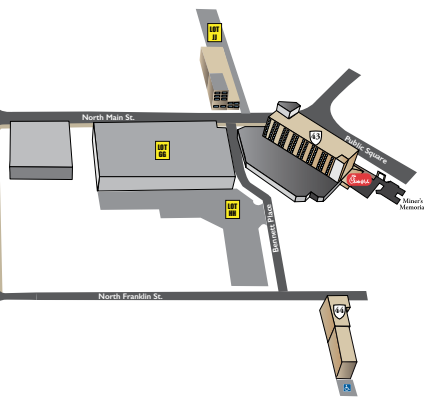
