Finish in Four (4)

The requirement for the degree of Bachelor of Arts or Bachelor of Science is the completion of a minimum of one hundred and twenty (120) semester hours of credit. Some majors require more than 120 semester credit hours for the student to be eligible to receive the degree.

A student is expected to earn at least sixty semester hours of credit, including the senior year, and 50% of the major sequence at King's College. It is the student's responsibility to select the courses that will satisfy the graduation requirements of the College.

Students must complete all course requirements in order to participate in graduation ceremonies. King's College will award only one bachelor's degree per graduate. The completion of additional majors will be entered on the student's transcript without designation of an additional degree.

If you are a full-time undergraduate student and your goal is to earn your degree within four (4) years you need to complete thirty (30) credits by the end of each academic year.

- **30** credits completed after Freshmen year
- **60** credits completed after Sophomore year
- 90 credits completed after Junior year
- **120** credits completed after Senior year = Graduation

If you are completing less credits after each year you might want to consider the following options in order to finish your degree within a four (4) year time frame.

- Complete additional credits during summers or over winter break.
- Overload, taking eighteen (18) credits in a fall or spring semester.
