

## King's College Access Grant for Study Abroad

The King's College Access Grant supports King's College students in their pursuit of study abroad. The fund is intended to make small grants to offset students' travel expenses and other costs associated with study abroad. The grant is part of the College's commitment to making global experiential learning affordable and accessible to a wide group of students.

## Eligibility:

Students of all majors are encouraged to apply for funds for programs of various types and lengths (including King's faculty-led study abroad programs). The following criteria will be used in deciding grant recipients:

- Demonstrate financial need.
- Preference will be given to students who show merit and have not had prior opportunities to travel or study abroad.

## Application Deadlines and Instructions:

Each academic year, students will apply in November. The specific application deadline will be announced on the Office of Study Abroad website.

To apply, students will use a common application form for study abroad scholarships available on the Study Abroad website. Students will submit:

- a letter of application for the King's College Access Grant for Study Abroad,
- a most recent transcript (either official or unofficial).

Students will be notified of awards within eight weeks after the application deadline; scholarships will be applied to student's study abroad account only upon evidence of acceptance to an approved program and a financial commitment (deposit).

## Additional Requirements:

After returning from studying abroad, scholarship recipients will reflect on their experiences and share them with the King's community by, for example, submitting a brief, captioned photo journal or participating in the Study Abroad Ambassadors program to promote Study Abroad on King's campus.
