

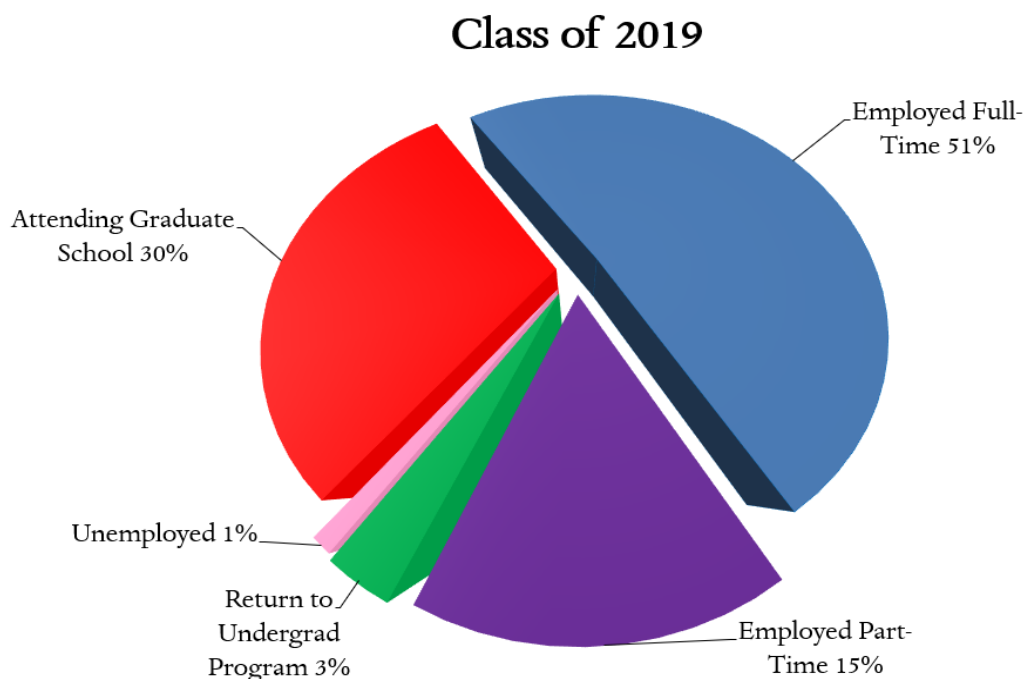
Placement Highlights For The Class of 2019

Each year the King's College Office of Career Planning prepares a report of our annual survey on the placement status of the graduates from the previous academic year. Information from this report has proven helpful to faculty, administrators, and staff in providing data to the stakeholders of King's College. The report includes highlights of the data gathered on the Class of 2019.

- **64%** or 274 of the 426 members of the class of 2019 obtaining a Bachelor's Degree responded to the survey.

Of the responding graduates:

- **99%** are employed full-time or part-time, or enrolled in undergraduate, graduate or professional school.
- **51%** are employed full-time.
- **30%** are attending graduate school or other professional school.
- **15%** are employed in part-time positions.
- **3%** are continuing their educations at King's College or other undergraduate institutions or in specialized training programs and other jobs which are transitions to full-time employment.
- **1%** are unemployed and seeking employment.
- **82%** of the graduates employed full-time are in occupations related directly to their fields of academic preparation.



Graduates Employed Full-Time

Of the 140 graduates who are employed full-time, 82% are working in jobs related to their fields of academic preparation. A breakdown of placements in and out of field and by region can be seen in the following charts.

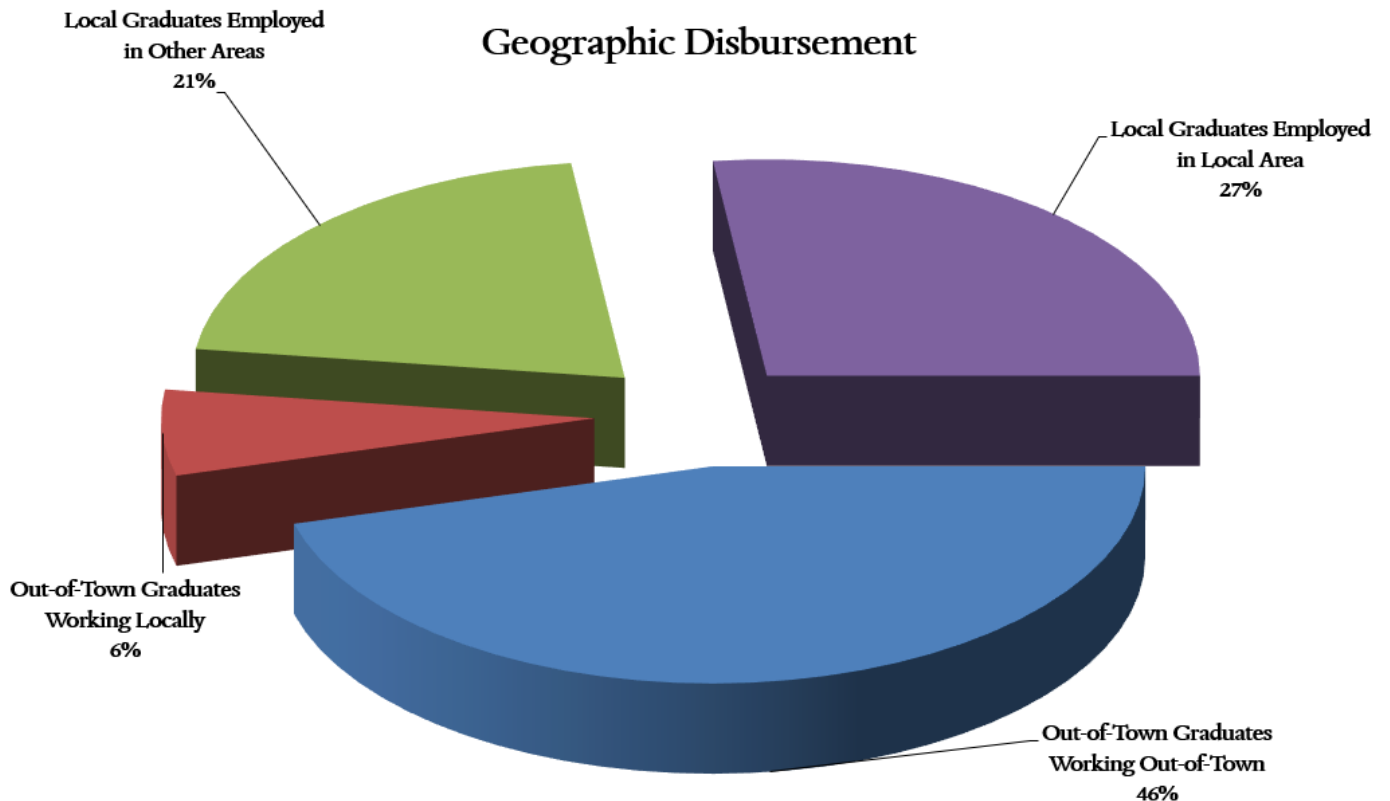

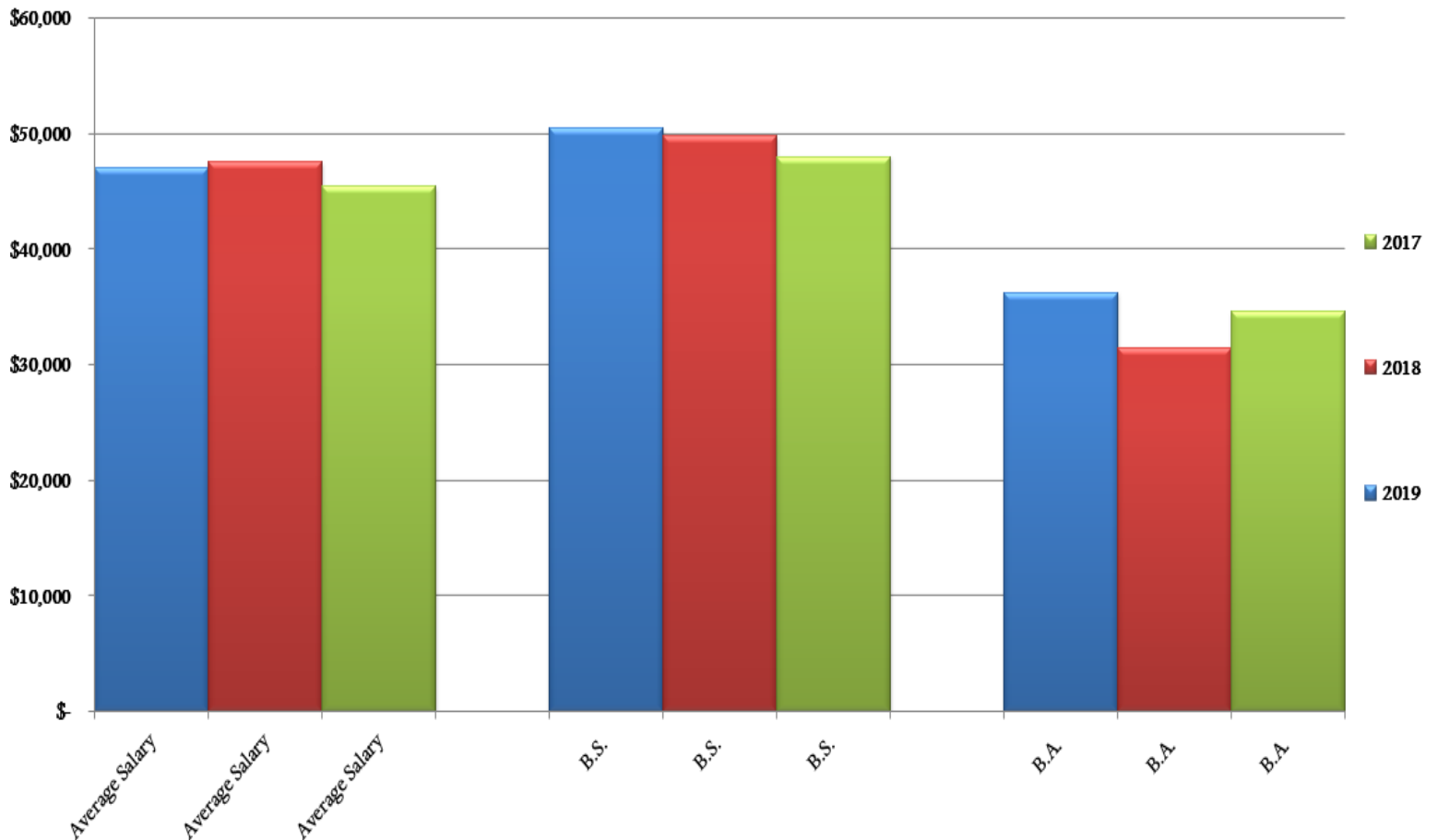

Salary Information

Salary information for the Class of 2019 was received from about 54% of the full-time employed graduates who responded to the salary question on the survey. The average salary for 2019 graduates was \$47,035. Bachelor of Science degree graduates were offered average salaries of \$50,438 and Bachelor of Arts degree graduates averaged \$36,259. There are significant variations in salary depending on academic major.

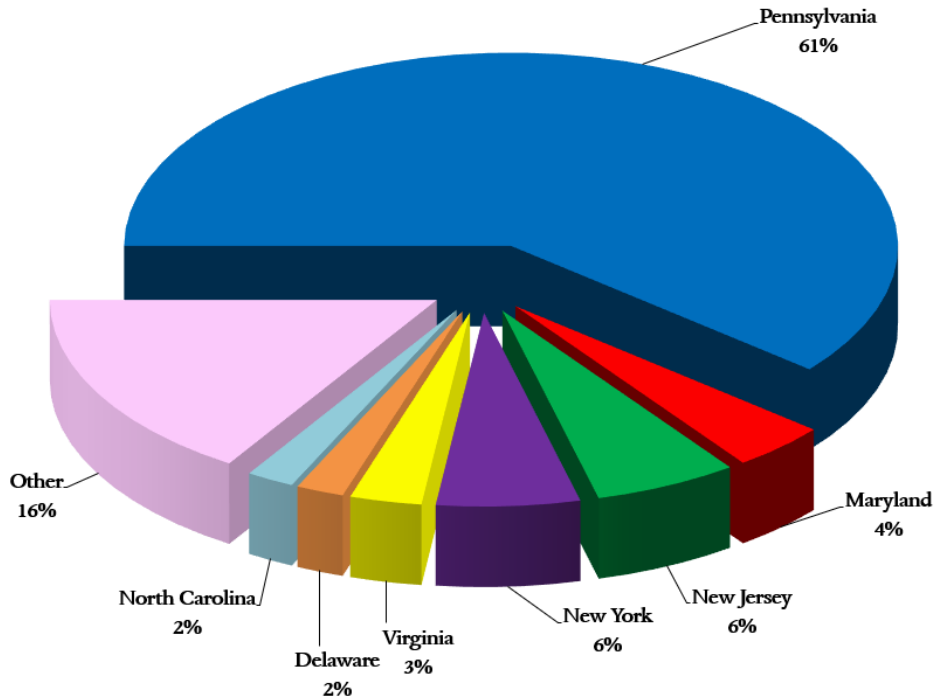
Three Year Salary Comparison



Geographic Employment

Many of graduates have secured employment in the Northeast Region of the country. Pennsylvania, New York, and New Jersey together employ 73% of the full-time responding graduates.

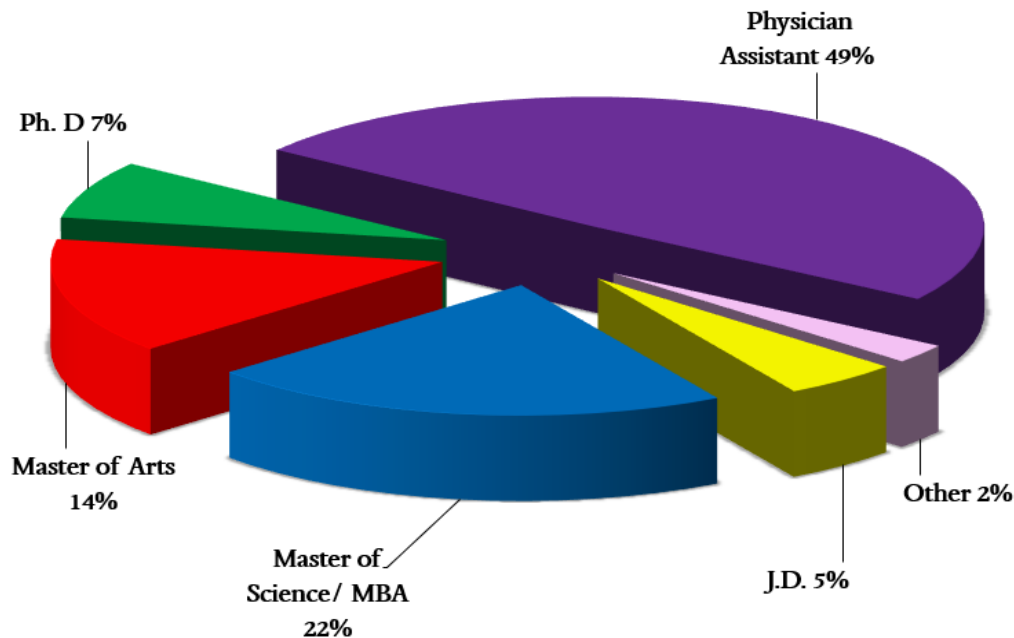
Geographic Placement of Graduates



Graduate School Placements

Of the responding population, 30% are attending graduate or professional school. Of the students attending graduate school, 49% are Physician Assistant students who are pursuing their Master's degrees. In addition, 36% of the graduates are enrolled in a Master of Science/ Master of Arts or MBA program and 14% are pursuing other advanced professional degrees.
