Travel

On November 20, 2020, the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania implemented new travel requirements for anyone who enters Pennsylvania from another state. The College has implemented the following policy regarding anyone- student, employee, or visitor- who has traveled outside of Pennsylvania, either domestic or international, and chooses to come onto the College campus in the County of Luzerne.

They must provide a copy of a negative COVID test result from a reputable source- testing site, medical provider, etc. The negative test may be a PCR or rapid test. Documentation is to be provided at least 24 hours in advance of the students return to campus to covidtestresults@kings.edu

Those who do not present a negative test result must quarantine for ten days or until they obtain negative test results at a location off-campus. Any expenses related to the quarantine are solely the responsibility of the student, employee, or visitor.

Students or employees who have a positive COVID test result or are symptomatic must not return to campus. They must seek medical assessment and treatment from their medical providers or non-College medical services.

Symptomatic, COVID 19 Test Positive or Pending and Tracing

Students who have a COVID 19 positive test result or are symptomatic must notify the College Student Health Center within 24 hours of the onset of their symptoms or positive test.

Students who have a positive COVID 19 test, are under investigation or waiting for test results must fully cooperate with tracing conducted by the Student Health Center or designees of their contacts. Students who do not cooperate or fail to provide the full information may not remain on campus since their behavior endangers the College community.
