The primary teaching responsibilities will be Microbiology and Immunology (including labs) for pre-PA, Biology, and related majors. Preference will be given to candidates with expertise in cellular and molecular biology, experience teaching immunology and microbiology, and demonstrated success with teaching at the college level. A Ph.D. in a related field is preferred for the Assistant Professor position, though strong ABD candidates will be considered. A master's degree in a relevant field is required for the instructor position. Teaching load is 4/4.
