Formal application to the Education Department between 48 and 60 credits – failure to complete EDUC 299 by 60 credits will result in the dropping of teacher certification in compliance with PDE regulations.

<sup>5</sup> Students should strongly consider taking MATH 101 and MATH 102 in place of MATH 120. The content of the MATH 101/MATH 102 sequence is consistent with the material found on the Basic Skills examination. Together, MATH 101 and MATH 102 satisfy the three math credits required for King's College Core Curriculum as well as the six-credit math requirement for Education.
