## General Information:

A student must earn a minimum of 120 credit hours to be awarded the baccalaureate degree. The number of credit hours required for graduation may be higher in certain major programs or if the student elects to pursue a second major. Beyond the requirements of the Core Curriculum and of a student's chosen major program, the balances of the credit hours required for graduation are "free electives."

For Education (PK-4) / Special Education (PK-12) majors, HIST 111 satisfies the History Core requirement, MATH 101 and MATH 102 together satisfy the Quantitative reasoning Core requirement, PHYS 100 satisfies the Scientific Endeavor Core requirement, NSCI 170-199 satisfies the Science in Context Core requirement, PSYC 101 satisfies the Human Behavior \& Social Institution Core requirement.
