Upon graduation, a student will receive a Bachelor of Science in Business Administration (B.S.B.A.) with a major in Management and a concentration in Entrepreneurship.

#### **General Information:**

A student must earn a minimum of 120 credit hours to be awarded the baccalaureate degree. The number of credit hours required for graduation may be higher in certain major programs <u>or</u> if the student elects to pursue a second major. **Management-Entrepreneurship requires 126 credits**. Beyond the requirements of the Core Curriculum and of a student's chosen major program, the balances of the credit hours required for graduation are "free electives."
