^{***} In addition to SPAN 105/SPAN 115, SPAN 231, SPAN 233, and SPAN 480, all students majoring in Spanish are required to take a Spanish literature course, a course with a focus on Latin America, and a course with a focus on Spain. See the table below for courses that count towards each of these categories. SPAN 291 & SPAN 391 may also satisfy these requirements when offered on appropriate topics. If a course is listed as both a Spanish literature course and a course with a focus on Spain or Latin America, it will satisfy both requirements, but the student will only earn 3 credits for the course. In this case, the student must take an additional SPAN Major course of his/her/their choosing to meet the 24-credit requirement.
