(Keep in mind that upper-level French Major Courses are offered on a rotating basis. So, choose the course when it is offered).

NOTE: If a student begins his/her study of a language at the beginning or intermediate level (FREN 101 - 104), he/she may not graduate within four years. He/she should consult with the Department Chair as early as possible to discuss different options such as taking French classes during the summer session or studying abroad in a French speaking country.

General Information:

A student must earn a minimum of 120 credit hours to be awarded the baccalaureate degree. The number of credit hours required for graduation may be higher in certain major programs or if the student elects to pursue a second major. Beyond the requirements of the Core Curriculum and of a student's chosen major program, the balances of the credit hours required for graduation are "free electives."
