*** Students must take additional Spanish courses from the following list to complete the major requirement of 24 credits. All students majoring in Spanish are required to take one course with a focus on Latin America and one course with a focus on Spain.

(Keep in mind that upper-level Spanish Major Courses are offered on a rotating basis. You should take each course when it is offered or consult with the Department Chair to see when it will be offered next).
