



ACCELERATED B.S. IN NURSING

According to the American Nurses Association, registered nurses (RNs) form the backbone of healthcare delivery in the United States, and there are more than four million RNs in the United States today (1 in every 100 people). Still, the need for RNs is greater than it's ever been as the healthcare industry expands. Nursing is both an art and a science—at its heart lies a fundamental respect for human dignity and an intuition for a patient's needs as they provide expert care from birth to the end of life in every community, large and small.

The Accelerated Bachelor of Science in Nursing Hybrid (ABSN-H) program at King's College offers students a rapid-paced, hybrid route to earning a bachelor's degree in nursing. In just 12 months, you can sit for the NCLEX-RN exam once you successfully complete the program to begin working as a registered nurse.

The ABSN-H program is tailored for graduates who already hold a bachelor's degree and are looking to shift careers through an accelerated-paced format. To be considered for this hybrid program, you must have earned a minimum 3.0 GPA (science-related) or 3.2 GPA (non-science-related) as well as completed 10 prerequisite core courses and four prerequisite science courses.* In an interview, the Director of Nursing will identify your ability to succeed in an accelerated-paced program.
