Dear King's College Students,

Best wishes as you complete the end of the fall semester and prepare to spend break with family and friends. We have done well at mitigating COVID-19 infections on campus, and appreciate everyone's cooperation. As we prepare for another safe campus experience in Spring 2022, King's College will require COVID-19 VACCINATION or submission of an informed consent waiver by January 10, 2022. If you have already submitted your vaccination card or waiver, you do not have to resubmit UNLESS there has been a change in your vaccination status or you received a booster dose. We will continue to require weekly COVID-19 surveillance testing for all unvaccinated individuals in the spring semester. Students who have tested positive after November 8, 2021 must submit a copy of their positive test result via email to [studenthealth@kings.edu](mailto:studenthealth@kings.edu). COVID-19 surveillance testing will be resumed after 90 days from the positive date. Vaccinated individuals are not required to test weekly nor quarantine if exposed to a COVID-19 positive person. **We continue to promote COVID-19 vaccination as the best available option to protect oneself and others by decreasing the severity of illness and risk from COVID-19 disease.**

<b>PARTIALLY VACCINATED STUDENTS:</b>	Initially fill out the online waiver <a href="https://go.kings.edu/studentwaiver">go.kings.edu/studentwaiver</a> or print and sign the waiver <a href="https://www.kings.edu/sites/default/files/student-covid-vaccine-informed-consent-waiver-2021.pdf">www.kings.edu/sites/default/files/student-covid-vaccine-informed-consent-waiver-2021.pdf</a> and submit to <a href="mailto:studenthealth@kings.edu">studenthealth@kings.edu</a> and follow the detailed requirements listed below. Once fully vaccinated the testing requirements will no longer apply.

<b>IF YOU ARE NOT FULLY VACCINATED PRIOR TO ARRIVAL, THE FOLLOWING IS REQUIRED:</b>  <b>ENTRY/RE-ENTRY COVID-19 TESTING</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• You <b>MUST</b> provide to King's proof of a negative COVID-19 test result within 3-5 days prior to your first day on campus. You can check for testing options in your home area such as CVS, Walgreens, Walmart, Rite Aid, or through your medical provider.</li> <li>• Mail in or home tests will be accepted but must clearly show the student's name, date of test, and test result.</li> <li>• Unless otherwise directed due to early arrival, you should obtain your test and submit the results between January 12 - January 17, 2022. A rapid antigen test or a PCR will be accepted. The test results should be immediately emailed to <a href="mailto:covidtestresults@kings.edu">covidtestresults@kings.edu</a>.</li> <li>• If your COVID-19 test result is positive, you should <b>NOT</b> come to campus and must notify <a href="mailto:reslife@kings.edu">reslife@kings.edu</a>, <a href="mailto:studenthealth@kings.edu">studenthealth@kings.edu</a>, and <a href="mailto:studentaffairs@kings.edu">studentaffairs@kings.edu</a>. We will provide detailed instructions. You should isolate at home prior to your arrival on campus and contact your medical provider if needed.</li> </ul>

<b>RESIDENTS:</b>	• Must supply the vaccine information or waiver with reentry testing BEFORE moving in to college owned housing.
<b>STUDENT-ATHLETES:</b>	• Must provide the same before participating in any pre-season activity.

<p><b>UNVACCINATED STUDENTS WHO FAIL TO COMPLETE WEEKLY SURVEILLANCE TESTING</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Will violate the student Code of Conduct, Regulation XIII: College Policies, and Regulation VIII: Failure to Follow a Directive Issued by the Student Affairs Office.</li> <li>• Students who violate the testing requirement will be issued: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>– First Offense a Censure (warning) and monetary of fine of \$75.00 to be paid within 15 days.</li> <li>– Second offense will result in a student placed on disciplinary probation for one year, a monetary fine of \$125.00 payable within 15 days and hold on the student account.</li> <li>– Third offense will result in the student's class schedule being canceled.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
