

Requirements for Application for Internal Change of Major/External Application To Nursing Program

- Must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.75 and TEAS score at the proficiency level
- Evidence of C or better in high school chemistry, biology and algebra or higher.
- Acceptance by LCCC for admission into nursing by Dec 1st
- Combined SAT requirement of 1000 for Math and Reading (ERW) (minimum of 450 in each) ACT Score of 21 or higher
- Students meeting or having met the above requirements will need to fill out an internal change of major to nursing form found on the nursing web page. This form should be initiated by the advisor and sent to Dr Cynthia Mailloux, Richard Abbas Alley Center of Health Sciences, Room 116B Chairperson of the Nursing Program.
- Students will need a copy of unofficial transcripts and a copy of SAT's scores to bring to advising appointment with nursing chairperson.
- Applicants meeting the Dec 1st deadline will be evaluated in the spring for admission into the program for the following fall.
- Admission into the Nursing program is determined by the number of available spots for internal applicants and the quality of those applying for admission. A minimum GPA of 2.75 and C's in required courses is not a guarantee of admission into Nursing.
