King's College HEALTH REQUIREMENTS FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

All international students must have a TB screening blood test performed during orientation.

HEALTH CHECK IS MANDATORY!

A health check will be administered **during orientation.** This is a **mandatory** requirement. Submission of health records is required at this time. If you do not submit the required health records, various waivers must be signed. Please bring your medical and immunization (vaccine) records with you to the health check.

Requirements for all Off Campus International Students

- Health Insurance: Include a copy of the front and back of your medical insurance card.
- Immunization Documents: Our immunization requirements follow the guidelines set by the American College Health Association and the Center for Disease Control.
 - Measles, Mumps, and Rubella Vaccines (2 doses)
- Tuberculosis Screening Test (Performed at mandatory orientation)

Requirements for all-International Students who live on and off campus wishing to use the Student Health Center

- Student Health History and Physical Exam Form; the physical examination must be done within one year of starting at King's College and signed by a health care provider.
- Health Insurance: Include a copy of the front and back of your medical insurance card. If you do not have proof of insurance, you will need to purchase online. Possible referrals include:

- Immunization Documents: Our requirements follow the guidelines set by the American College Health Association and the Center for Disease Control.

 - -Resident students: Meningococcal vaccine date/s or waiver.
