Modification to the Campus Masking Policy Effective April 2, 2022

The King's College community has followed a masking policy for the last several years, which has helped mitigate the spread of COVID-19.

Modified Masking Policy

Due to the continued low-level COVID status for Luzerne County and the low rate of COVID cases on campus, we will update our mask policy effective April 2.

- Mask wearing is **OPTIONAL** in all areas on campus.
- The College will continue to have masks and hand sanitizer available in the stations on campus.
- While wearing masks is not required in college classrooms or offices, it is expected that a student, visitor, or employee will wear a mask if requested. Therefore, please respect an individual's request to wear masks.
- Students and employees should carry a mask with them so they can wear a mask when requested.
- Any person with symptoms or illness should not attend class or activities on campus and should wear a mask around other people. Students should contact the Student Health Center at studenthealth@kings.edu or call 570-208-5852. Employees should contact their supervisor and hr@kings.edu if they have questions.

COVID-19 Vaccination

The College strongly encourages all people to be vaccinated and boosted.

Surveillance Testing

The College will continue with weekly surveillance testing. Individuals who receive a notice of testing must schedule an appointment and complete the testing.

Future Changes

The College will monitor the number of cases on campus and in the local area and update its policy and procedures as the situation changes. An increase in the number of cases on campus or in the local area may increase mitigation efforts, including wearing masks on campus.
