

Drug Conviction and Financial Aid

(taken from the King's College 2018-19 Student Handbook, pg. 34)

If you have been convicted (federal or state convictions only) of possession or sale of illegal drugs for an offense that occurred while receiving federal student aid (grants, loans or work-study), you may not be eligible to receive federal aid. Convictions which were removed from your record or which occurred before age 18 (unless tried as an adult) do not count.

To determine if you are eligible for federal student aid, or what you must do to regain eligibility, you may contact the Financial Aid Office.
