

## Quarantine Recommendations After SARS-CoV 2 Vaccinations February 15, 2021

In alignment with the recent CDC update on Feb 10<sup>th</sup>, 2021 and the PA DOH Health Alert Network Update on 2/12/2021 we are adjusting our quarantine protocol following vaccination to the following:

People who are fully vaccinated against COVID-19 do **NOT** need to quarantine after an exposure to another person with COVID-19 if they meet **ALL** the following criteria:

- They are fully vaccinated (i.e,  $\geq$  weeks following receipt of the second dose in a 2-dose series, or  $\geq$  2 weeks following receipt of one dose of a single-dose vaccine);
- They are within 3 months following receipt of the last dose in the series;  
**AND,**
- They have remained asymptomatic since the current COVID-19 exposure.

**Regardless of vaccination status**, persons who exhibit **new or unexplained symptoms of COVID-19** still need to **isolate** and be evaluated for COVID-19 testing.

Due to this recent update, we will begin to collect vaccination documentation.

Students: After completion of the second dose in a 2-dose series, or one dose in a single-dose vaccine, please upload the vaccination document through this link [Student Health Portal](#). It will become a part of the student's electronic medical record.
