



## **Marjorie Neusch Massey Scholarship Fund for Study Abroad**

### **Information Sheet - 2021**

The Marjorie Neusch Massey Scholarship Fund supports King's College students in their pursuit of study abroad. The fund was started in 2006 in memory of Associate Professor of Spanish Anne Massey's mother, Marjorie Neusch Massey. The scholarships are intended to encourage students to get out of their comfort zones by attending high-quality study abroad programs that expose them to new cultural, linguistic, academic, and social experiences.

#### **Eligibility:**

- Demonstrate financial need
- Preference will be given to students travelling to a non-English speaking country who have not had prior opportunities to travel outside of the United States.
- Students are encouraged to apply for funds for programs of a variety of types and lengths (including King's faculty-led study abroad programs).

#### **Application Deadlines:**

Application deadline is Thursday, April 1<sup>st</sup>, 2021 (for study in Summer 2021 or Fall 2021). Submit applications online only the online application form provided by the Office of Study Abroad.

Students will be notified of awards soon after applying; scholarships will be applied to your account upon evidence of acceptance to an approved program and a financial commitment (deposit). Scholarship may be used for virtual study e-broad from an approved provider.

#### **Requirements:**

Grant recipients will reflect upon and share their experiences with the King's community by submitting a small, captioned photo essay. Specific instructions and support will be given to this end.

Grant recipients are also typically expected to attend an event with King's Office of Institutional Advancement, which brings together student scholarship recipients and donors.
