Dear Resident Student—

This memo details several changes to the College's visitation policy, as well as updated sanctions for violations of the College's COVID Policy. It is your responsibility to read and understand this material. Residence Life reserves the right to make any changes to these protocols, should the situation warrant, and students will be notified of all changes in advance of them being enacted.

Visitation

- There will be no visitation until noon on Friday, February 5, 2021. Only the residents of a building will be permitted into the residential portion of that building.
- Beginning at noon on Friday, February 5, 2021, only resident students will be able to visit friends in other residence halls. This will be in effect until noon on Monday, February 15, 2021.
- All students will be permitted to visit the residence halls and college apartments beginning at noon on Monday, February 15, 2021. All other College policies regarding visitation, COVID, and the Student Code of Conduct must be followed.

The following visitation protocols from the fall 2020 semester remain in effect. The College will not permit guests from outside of the King's College community to enter any residential spaces for daytime or overnight visits. This includes family members, friends from home, prospective students, athletic recruits, and others.

Resident students remain limited to one King's guest per resident per room, and masks **must** be worn while guests are present.

- If you live in a double room in Esseff/Holy Cross/Luksic, you and your roommate may each have a King's guest, with no more than four people in the room at one time.
- If you live in a single room in Esseff/Holy Cross/Luksic, you may have one King's guest, with no more than two people in the room at one time.
- If you live in a triple in Holy Cross, you and your roommates may each have a King's guest, with no more than six people in the room at one time.
- If you live in an apartment, you and your roommates may each have a King's guest, with no more than six (for a three-person apartment) or eight (for a four-person apartment) people in the apartment at one time.

Sanctions for COVID Policy Violations

Gathering in an on-campus residence hall room or apartment. Specifically defined, a gathering is one that exceeds the maximum size defined in the prior section on visitation. Please note that these sanctions also apply to off-campus behavior.

- **First Offense:** censure, \$100.00 per resident and suspension from co-curricular activities, including (non-academic) clubs, organizations, and athletics for one year.
- **Second Offense:** suspension from the College for not less than one full semester.

On campus violations of the mask requirement, maximum-listed elevator occupancy and/or social distancing.

- \$50.00 per offense; repeated offenses result in increased fines.
