

Student Conduct Sanctions- COVID 19 Related, January 2021

If a student does not participate in pre-entry testing and provide required documentation, their registration and on-campus housing will be canceled. (February 8th is the drop/add date for the Spring.)

If a student indicates they will not participate in surveillance testing: registration and on-campus housing are canceled.

Student misses their assigned surveillance test: First time \$100, reduced to \$50 if the student reports for assigned testing the following week; second offense \$100 and suspension if the student does not report for the assigned testing the following week.

Off-campus housing and on-campus apartments and residence

halls: house/apartment/room event/gathering/party beyond the limit residents: first time: censure, \$100 per resident and suspension from co-curricular activities-- (nonacademic) clubs, organizations, athletics for one year. Second offense: Suspension from the College for not less than one full semester.

Violation of mask-wearing, social distancing, and elevator occupancy limits: first offense: \$50; second offense \$75; third offense \$100; fourth offense suspension from the College.
