



## COVID-19 Travel Procedures - Revised June 2021

On March 1, 2021, the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania rescinded the travel restrictions from other states into Pennsylvania requiring testing and/or quarantine. The order was rescinded based on the trend of reduction of cases. The Commonwealth may change the current order based on the number of new cases.

All students and employees, when traveling on public transportation for example air flights, need to take the appropriate precautions to protect themselves and others by continuing to wear a mask and maintaining a six-foot social distancing along with frequent hand washing. This applies to those people who have received one of the COVID 19 vaccines.

Students and employees who travel outside of the United States must follow all testing and quarantine guidelines recommended by the Center for Disease Control and the US Department of State. Foreign travelers must provide the College with a negative COVID 19 test result completed within three days of their reentry into the US and are to self-quarantine until they have the test result and provide it to the College- students provide results to [studenthealth@kings.edu](mailto:studenthealth@kings.edu) and employees to [hr@kings.edu](mailto:hr@kings.edu).

Students or employees who have a positive COVID test result or are symptomatic must not return to campus. They must seek medical assessment and treatment from their medical providers or non-College medical services.

### Symptomatic, COVID 19 Test Positive or Pending and Tracing

Students who have a COVID 19 positive test result or are symptomatic must notify the College Student Health Center within 24 hours of the onset of their symptoms or positive test.

Students who have a positive COVID 19 test, are under investigation or waiting for test results must fully cooperate with tracing conducted by the Student Health Center or designees of their contacts. Students who do not cooperate or fail to provide the full information may not remain on campus since their behavior endangers the College community.

Employees who have a positive test must also refrain from campus and notify Human Resources and their supervisor to discuss their time off.
